1 INTRODUCTION

- As part of the data that is being collected for this study, you will be asked to complete an electronic questionnaire, called ePROs (**e**lectronic **P**atient **R**eported **O**utcomes) – FIND-CRC Questionnaire.
- The FIND-CRC Questionnaire is specific to the Pre-Colonoscopy Blood Draw and you will be expected to complete it one time prior to your colonoscopy.
- The ePRO may be completed during a scheduled in-clinic visit or remotely on your own device such as a personal smartphone, tablet or computer.

2 TECHNICAL INFORMATION

2.1 CREATING YOUR ACCOUNT

Please bring your own device or mobile phone for completing your In-Clinic questionnaires during your Clinic visit.

2.1.1 BRING YOUR OWN DEVICE:

Provide the clinic staff with your personal email address. Only you and the clinic staff will share this information. Your email address will be your Medrio login username for the study.

2.1.2 CREATE YOUR ACCOUNT:

On your first visit to the clinic, the clinic staff will enter your email address and the visit date into Medrio to trigger the questionnaire. The Medrio system will automatically send a welcome email to the email address that you have provided. Open the Medrio email and click or tap on the link in the email to create your account.



Questionnaires will be available under the PENDING Tab. Click or tap on the Launch icon to launch the questionnaire.






